**ORDINANCE No. 2015-030**

**AN ORDINANCE calling a public hearing concerning the intent of the City Council of the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois, to sell not to exceed \$1,300,000 General Obligation Alternate Revenue Bonds.**

WHEREAS, the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois (the "*City*"), is a duly organized and existing municipality incorporated and existing under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is now operating under the provisions of Illinois Municipal Code, as amended (the "*Code*"), and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, including the Local Government Debt Reform Act of the State of Illinois, as amended (the "*Debt Reform Act*"); and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City (the "*Council*") intends to sell alternate revenue bonds in the amount of not to exceed \$1,300,000 (the "*Bonds*") to pay the costs of (i) improvements to the City-owned combined waterworks and sewerage system, including a sewage relining/inspection project, and replacement and redesign of certain portions of the Water System, including replacement of a relief combination sewer; (ii) improvements to certain public facilities, including but not limited to (a) certain Illinois Environmental Protection Agency-mandated improvements to a leachate treatment system located at the City-owned golf course, and (b) the rehabilitation of the irrigation system and other improvements at the Golf Course; and (iii) the acquisition of an ambulance to replace and upgrade the City's ambulance fleet (and replace an out-of-service ambulance) and the acquisition of public works vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Bond Issue Notification Act of the State of Illinois, as amended, requires the Council to hold a public hearing concerning the Council's intent to sell the Bonds before adopting an ordinance providing for the sale of the Bonds:

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It and It Is Hereby Ordained by the City Council of the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

1. **Incorporation of Preambles.** The Council hereby finds that all of the recitals contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct and does incorporate them into this Ordinance by reference.

2. **Public Hearing.** The Council hereby calls a public hearing to be held at 6:30 o'clock P.M. on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2015, in the City Hall, 13051 Greenwood Avenue, Blue Island, Illinois, concerning the Council's intent to sell the Bonds and to receive public comments regarding the proposal to sell the Bonds (the "*Hearing*").

3. **Notice.** The City Clerk (the "*City Clerk*") shall (i) publish notice of the Hearing at least once in the *Daily Southtown*, the same being a newspaper of general circulation in the City, not less than 7 nor more than 30 days before the date of the Hearing, and (ii) post at least 48 hours before the Hearing a copy of said notice at the principal office of the Council.

4. **Form of Notice.** Notice of the Hearing shall appear above the name of the City Clerk and shall be in substantially the following form:

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois (the "City"), will hold a public hearing on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2015, at 6:30 o'clock P.M. The hearing will be held in the City Hall, East Annex, 2434 Vermont, Blue Island, Illinois. The purpose of the hearing will be to receive public comments on the proposal to sell general obligation alternate revenue bonds of the City in the amount of not to exceed \$1,300,000 to pay the costs of (i) improvements to the City-owned combined waterworks and sewerage system, including a sewage relining/inspection project, and replacement and redesign of certain portions of the Water System, including replacement of a relief combination sewer; (ii) improvements to certain public facilities, including but not limited to (a) certain Illinois Environmental Protection Agency-mandated improvements to a leachate treatment system located at the City-owned golf course, and (b) the rehabilitation of the irrigation system and other improvements at the Golf Course; and (iii) the acquisition of an ambulance to replace and upgrade the City's ambulance fleet (and replace an out-of-service ambulance) and the acquisition of public works vehicles.



5. **Hearing Requirements.** At the Hearing, the Council shall explain the reasons for the proposed bond issue and permit persons desiring to be heard an opportunity to present written or oral testimony within reasonable time limits. The Council shall not adopt an ordinance selling the Bonds for a period of seven (7) days after the final adjournment of the Hearing.


6. **Severability.** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

7. **Repeal.** All Ordinances and parts thereof in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption.






