**WHEREAS**, the Cities, Villages and Towns named in the Intergovernmental Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A" are public agencies within the meaning of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, as set forth in 5 ILCS 220/1 *et seq.*; and

**WHEREAS**, Article VII, Section 10, of the Illinois Constitution of 1970 and the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act authorize units of local government to enter into intergovernmental agreements pertaining to intergovernmental activities; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has determined it is in the best interests of the public health, safety and welfare of its citizens to participate in the FY 2018 Justice Assistance Grant ("JAG") Program Award; and

**WHEREAS**, the parties have determined that it is reasonable, necessary and in the public interest and welfare to work cooperatively to facilitate participation in the JAG Program Award; and

**WHEREAS**, the parties have decided to delineate their duties and responsibilities concerning participation in the JAG Program Award;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLUE ISLAND, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION ONE:** The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated as if said recitals were fully set forth within this Section One.

**SECTION TWO:** The Intergovernmental Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A" is hereby approved and the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute said Intergovernmental Agreement in substantially the form attached hereto.

**SECTION THREE:** All policies, resolutions and ordinances of the City of Blue Island which conflict with this ordinance shall be, and they are hereby, repealed.


**SECTION FOUR:** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.





FISCAL YEAR 2018 JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM AWARD**

**INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT**

**FY 2018 JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM AWARD**

BY AND AMONG CITY OF CHICAGO, the COUNTY of COOK, CITY OF BERWYN, CITY OF BLUE ISLAND, CITY OF CALUMET CITY, CITY OF CHICAGO HEIGHTS, TOWN OF CICERO, VILLAGE OF DOLTON, CITY OF EVANSTON, CITY OF HARVEY, VILLAGE OF MAYWOOD, VILLAGE OF RIVERDALE AND THE VILLAGE OF SKOKIE.

This Intergovernmental Agreement ("IGA") is made and entered into as of \_\_\_\_\_, 2019, by and among the City of Chicago ("Chicago"), a municipal corporation and home rule unit of government under Article VII, Section 6(a) of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, by and through its Department of Police ("CPD"), and the County of Cook, City of Berwyn, City of Blue Island, City of Calumet City, City of Chicago Heights, Town of Cicero, Village of Dolton, City of Evanston, City of Harvey, Village of Maywood, Village of Riverdale and the Village of Skokie, (each (except for Chicago), a "Governing Body").

**RECITALS**

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Justice Assistance ("BJA") of the Office of Justice Programs ("OJP") of the United States Department of Justice supports law enforcement programs, court and corrections programs, drug treatment, victim assistance services, and the upgrading of technology in connection with prevention initiatives that strengthen the nation's criminal justice system; and

WHEREAS, the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant ("JAG") Program (the "Program") is administered by the BJA and provides funding that supports states, tribes and local governments in a broad range of activities to prevent and control crime based on their own local needs and conditions; and

WHEREAS, jurisdictions identified by BJA as "disparate" under the Program must identify a fiscal agent local unit of government that will submit a joint application for the aggregate eligible allocation to all disparate municipalities and local governments, specifying the award distribution that would be made to each disparate entity; and

WHEREAS, if a Program award is made to such fiscal agent, said entity will undertake to distribute the correct allocation of award funds to each disparate entity through subawards that include all appropriate award conditions; and

WHEREAS, Chicago has agreed to serve as the fiscal agent municipality for the FY 2018 Program for this jurisdiction and to undertake the required distributions by subaward to each disparate entity; and

WHEREAS, each Governing Body is a disparate entity for purposes of the FY 2018 Program for this jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, Chicago and each Governing Body must establish separate trust funds in which to deposit their respective JAG funds, and

WHEREAS, Chicago and each Governing Body desire to enter into this IGA to provide for the responsibilities and obligation of the parties hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Chicago Superintendent of Police is authorized to enter into this IGA by Section 8 of the 2018 Annual Appropriation Ordinance that was enacted by the City Council of the City of Chicago on November 21, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the signatory party for each respective Governing Body hereunder affirms that he or she is authorized to enter into this IGA by an ordinance or similar enactment by such Governing Body;

Now, therefore, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements contained herein, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agrees as follows:

ARTICLE ONE: INCORPORATION OF RECITALS

The recital set forth above are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.

ARTICLE TWO: PROGRAM ALLOCATIONS

SECTION 1. In its fiscal agent role hereunder, Chicago has received or will be receiving an award of JAG Program funding from the BJA in the amount of \$2,268,856.00 (“Aggregate Funding”), of which Chicago's allocation will be \$1,625,951.00 (“Chicago Allocation”).

SECTION 2. In its role as fiscal agent, Chicago will allocate the entirety of the Aggregate Funding, less the amount of Chicago Allocation, as follows, and each Governing Body agrees to accept its stated allocation:

Cook County:	\$494,802.00
City of Berwyn:	\$10,462.00
City of Blue Island:	\$9,716.00
City of Calumet City:	\$15,680.00
City of Chicago Heights:	\$13,841.00
Town of Cicero:	\$19,557.00
Village of Dolton:	\$9,741.00
City of Evanston:	\$10,238.00
City of Harvey:	\$20,252.00
Village of Maywood:	\$15,232.00
Village of Riverdale:	\$11,331.00
Village of Skokie:	\$12,052.00

SECTION 3. Nothing in this IGA shall impose any liability upon any party to this IGA other than liability may be imposed under law.

SECTION 4. Each party to this IGA will be responsible for its own actions in providing services under this IGA and shall not be liable for any civil liability that may arise from the furnishing of services by the other parties.

SECTION 5. The parties to this IGA do not intend any third party to obtain a right by virtue of this IGA.

SECTION 6. By entering into this IGA, the parties hereto do not intend to create any obligations other than those set out herein.

SECTION 7. Each party hereto will observe its respective rights and obligations under the JAG Program solicitation document set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto.

#### ARTICLE THREE: TERM

The term of this IGA shall commence on the date of its execution and shall expire when BJA provides a final close-out notice for the FY 2018 grant or on September 30, 2021, whichever may occur later.

#### ARTICLE FOUR: TRUST FUNDS

Each Governing Body will establish an individual Trust Fund for its respective JAG funds pursuant to the JAG guidelines. Chicago will deposit its Chicago Allocation of JAG funds, including \$137,790.00 thereof specifically to be used for administrative purposes, into an interest bearing account.

#### ARTICLE FIVE: CONSENT

All parties to this IGA agree and consent to Chicago being the fiscal agent for the Program.

#### ARTICLE SIX: REPORTS

Each Governing Body shall submit to CPD the quarterly and annual performance and quarterly fiscal reports required under the Program for the periods of January through March, April through June, July through September and October through December. Each quarterly report shall be due 15 days after each quarter ends and the annual performance report shall be due by October 15 of each year.

#### ARTICLE NINE: COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS

The parties hereto shall comply with all with all federal, state and municipal laws, ordinances, rule and regulations that may pertain to the IGA.

#### ARTICLE TEN: GOVERNING LAW AND SEVERABILITY

This IGA shall be governed by the laws of the State of Illinois. The invalidity of any one or more phrases, sentences, clauses or sections contained in this IGA shall not affect the remaining portions of this IGA.

ARTICLE ELEVEN: COUNTERPARTS

This IGA may be executed in counterparts.

ARTICLE TWELVE: ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This IGA constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and shall supersede any and all prior agreements regarding the subject matter.

ARTICLE THIRTEEN: HEADINGS

The headings and titles of this IGA are for convenience only and shall not influence the construction or interpretation of this IGA.

ARTICLE FOURTEEN: DISCLAIMER OF RELATIONSHIP

Nothing contained in this IGA, nor any act of the parties, shall be deemed or construed by any of the parties hereto or by third persons to create any relationship of third party beneficiary, limited or general partnership or joint venture with or among the parties.

ARTICLE FIFTEEN: NO PERSONAL LIABILITY

No member, official, employee or agent of any of the parties to this IGA shall be individually or personally liable in connection with this IGA.

ARTICLE SIXTEEN: REPRESENTATIVES
