NORTH AND FULTON STREET ON THE SOUTH IN THE
CITY OF BLUE ISLAND AND PROVIDING PENALTIES
FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF**

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BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Blue Island, County of Cook and State of Illinois as follows:

SECTION ONE

The word “park” shall mean the standing of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, otherwise than when temporarily and actually engaged in loading or unloading of merchandise, property or passengers, and except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic, or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or traffic control signal or device.

SECTION TWO

Residential Permit Parking: Those portions of the following described streets, within the City of Blue Island, as hereinafter defined, are hereby designated Permit Parking Only District B1: the east side of Chatham Street beginning with its intersection with Vermont Street on the north and Fulton Street on the south in the City of Blue Island. The parking restrictions set forth in this section shall be in effect from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.; Mondays through Fridays. The parking restrictions shall not apply on Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays.

SECTION THREE

Appropriate signs shall be erected by the Superintendent of Public Works informing the public that parking thereon is prohibited as provided in this ordinance.

SECTION FOUR

Upon receipt of an application and appropriate proof of actual residence within the Residential Permit Parking Only District B1, the City Clerk is hereby authorized to issue annual "Residential Parking Permit" decals to residents of the district whose principal place of residence is located in the district. Upon receipt of an application and appropriate proof of business registration and license, the City Clerk is hereby authorized to issue annual "B1 Parking Permit" decals to the applicant whose principal place of business is located in the district. The City Clerk shall be responsible for accepting, processing and issuing Residential Parking Permits and Temporary Visitor Permits and verifying the applicant's compliance with licensing, certification and registration requirements and the fact that the applicant has no outstanding City parking citations attributable to the applicant or applicant's vehicle prior to issuance.

SECTION FIVE

The owner of any vehicle violating or failing to comply with the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be fined not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) nor more than Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) for each offense, and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

SECTION SIX

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law. A full, true and complete copy of this ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form, by authority of the City Council as corporate authorities.


SECTION SEVEN






