**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BLUE ISLAND, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS,
AMENDING SECTION 50.08 OF THE CODE OF BLUE ISLAND, ILLINOIS
REGARDING THE PICK-UP AND STORAGE OF GARBAGE RECEPTACLES**

WHEREAS, the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois (the “*City*”) is a duly organized and existing city created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and is now operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, with full powers to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions for the benefits of the residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Council (the “*Corporate Authorities*”) are committed to ensuring the effective administration of government; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities may from time to time amend the text of the Code of Blue Island, Illinois when it is determined to be in the best interests of the City and the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities find that amending the Code of the City of Blue Island, Illinois to regulate the use, pick-up and storage of garbage receptacles within the City to be in the best interest of the City and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. The Corporate Authorities find and determine that the adoption of this Ordinance is in the best interests of the City as well as in the public interest.

Section 3. Accordingly, Section 50.02 (*“Receptacles; Specifications”*) of Chapter 50 (*“Garbage”*) of Title V (*“Public Works”*) of the Code of Blue Island, Illinois is hereby amended by deleting the stricken language and adding the underlined language as follows:

§ 50.02 RECEPTACLES; SPECIFICATIONS.

...

(B) Receptacles for garbage, ashes and waste shall be water-tight and made of metal, rubber or plastic with close-fitted covers made of the same materials. Each receptacle shall not exceed 40 gallons in capacity and a sufficient number shall be provided to contain at least a seven-day accumulation of garbage, ashes and waste for the premises in question. The receptacles, whether empty or full, must be stored out of view of any public right-of-way. For collection, the receptacles shall be placed in a convenient place on or near said premises for the removal of their contents on such days at such times and in such manner as the Superintendent of Streets may assign direct. Notwithstanding the foregoing, receptacles subject to curb pick-up shall not be placed upon city streets or any city property for pick-up prior to 4:00 p.m. on the evening before the assigned pick-up day for the particular area of the city and all such aforementioned refuse containers shall be removed and placed back upon private property by 11:59 p.m. of the assigned day of pick-up.

Section 4. Section 50.08 (*“Deposits on Streets or Alleys Prohibited; Exception”*) of Chapter 50 (*“Garbage”*) of Title V (*“Public Works”*) of the Code of Blue Island, Illinois is hereby amended by deleting the stricken language and adding the underlined language as follows:

§ 50.08 DEPOSITS ON STREETS OR ALLEYS PROHIBITED; EXCEPTION.

No person shall deposit or place in or upon any sidewalk, street, alley, parkway or public place in the city, any refuse of any kind. However, this section shall not apply to the deposit of material under a permit authorized by an ordinance of the city; nor to goods, wares or merchandise deposited upon any street, sidewalk, alley or other public place temporarily in the necessary course of trade and removed therefrom within two hours after being deposited; nor to articles or things deposited in or conducted into the city sewerage system through lawful drains, in accordance with the ordinances of the city relating thereto; nor to receptacles placed lawfully on city property in accordance with this chapter.

Section 5. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 6. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


Section 7. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, as a matter of urgency, to preserve and protect the health, safety, and welfare of the City and its residents pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/1-2-4.




