**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BLUE ISLAND, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS,
ESTABLISHING RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON
THE SOUTH SIDE OF CANAL STREET BETWEEN ITS INTERSECTION WITH
HOYNE AVENUE TO THE EAST AND CHICAGO STREET TO THE WEST IN
THE CITY OF BLUE ISLAND AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE
VIOLATION THEREOF**

WHEREAS, the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois (the "*City*") is a duly organized and existing city created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and is now operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, with full powers to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions for the benefits of the residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Council (the "*Corporate Authorities*") are committed to ensuring the effective administration of government; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities are charged with the responsibility of regulating parking and traffic requirements within the City; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities find that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City to provide for the regulations herein specified.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. The Corporate Authorities find and determine that the adoption of this Ordinance is in the best interests of the City as well as in the public interest.


