ORDINANCE NO. 2020-003

**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING UPON A
PORTION OF A CERTAIN STREET WITHIN
THE CITY OF BLUE ISLAND, COUNTY OF COOK,
STATE OF ILLINOIS, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES
FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF**

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Blue Island, County of Cook and State of Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE

The word “park” shall mean the standing of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, otherwise than when temporarily and actually engaged in loading or unloading of merchandise, property or passengers, and except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic, or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or traffic control signal or device.

SECTION TWO

It shall be unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to park said vehicle on that portion of the following street, within the City of Blue Island, as hereinafter designated:

On Florence Street from its intersection with Irving Street on the west to a point on the east where Florence Street intersects with the entrance to the existing industrial park. (See Exhibit “A” attached hereto for a description and photograph of the portion of Florence Street where parking is prohibited)

SECTION THREE

Appropriate signs shall be erected by the Superintendent of Public Works informing the public that parking thereon is prohibited as hereinabove provided.

SECTION FOUR

The operator of any vehicle violating or failing to comply with the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be fined not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) nor more than

Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) for each offense, and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

SECTION FIVE

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION SIX

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law. A full, true and complete copy of this ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form, by authority of the City Council as corporate authorities.




Request for No Parking Signage

No Parking signage installation is being requested on Florence Street, from Irving Avenue east to the entrance of an industrial park. The street is approximately 150 feet long and 17 feet wide. When cars are parked on Florence, large vehicles such as emergency vehicles, public works vehicles and trucks delivering to the industrial park have difficulty driving down the street. At times large vehicles have been unable to even access Florence or the industrial park because of the location of cars parked along the street (see attached picture).
