ORDINANCE NO. 2020-018

AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING A PORTION OF A CERTAIN STREET AT OR NEAR 12718 GREENWOOD AVENUE FOR HANDICAPPED PARKING ONLY WITHIN THE CITY OF BLUE ISLAND, COUNTY OF COOK, STATE OF ILLINOIS, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, it is the public policy of the State of Illinois, as enunciated in the State Constitution, that handicapped persons are entitled to enjoy the fruits of a full and meaningful life; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Blue Island hereby declare that it is the public policy of the city to encourage and assist handicapped persons to participate fully in the social and economic life of our community; and

WHEREAS, to implement such policy the Mayor and City Council of the City of Blue Island recognize it is desirable to restrict certain portions of the public ways within the City of Blue Island for handicapped parking only;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Blue Island, County of Cook and State of Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE

That this portion of the street within the City of Blue Island, as hereinafter designated, is hereby restricted for handicapped parking only:

- a) On the west side of Greenwood Avenue in front of the residence whose common address is 12718 Greenwood Avenue (one space consisting of a total of twenty (20') feet)

SECTION TWO

Appropriate signs shall be erected by the Superintendent of Public Works on the portion of the street designated above informing the public that parking thereon is restricted or permitted as hereinabove provided for.

SECTION THREE

The operator of any vehicle violating or failing to comply with the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction be fined not less than Three Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$350.00) for each offense.

SECTION FOUR

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION FIVE







Roll call taken of the committee with Aldermen Raeann Cantelo-Zylman, Alderman Johnny Ringo Hill, and Alderman Tom Hawley present. Alderman Kevin Donahue absent. Also, in attendance Clerk Randy Heuser as moderator, Kimberly Byrne and our tech/videographer Ben Tomera.

Emailed public comments received will be read during the Public Comment portion of the meeting by Alderman Nancy Rita. No public comment.

Amending Cannabis Business Establishment Ordinance - AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BLUE ISLAND COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS AMENDING TITLE IX (BUSINESS REGULATIONS) OF THE CODE OF BLUE ISLAND, ILLINOIS REGARDING CANNABIS BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS. Alderman Cantelo-Zylman began a discussion regarding what the surrounding areas are charging. Decision by the committee requesting Howard Coppari to put together a spreadsheet of surrounding areas and amount they are charging to apply for a license and yearly renewal.

Amending Cannabis Offenses Ordinance –AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BLUE ISLAND COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS AMENDING TITLE VII, CHAPTER 70 (TRAFFIC CODE) AND TITLE XIII, CHAPTER 30 (GENERAL OFFENSES) OF THE CODE OF BLUE ISLAND, ILLINOIS. This was discussed and passed in the Public Safety meeting per Chair Jim Klinker.

- Motion by Alderman Hawley, 2nd by Alderman Cantelo-Zylman. Voice vote, all in favor, motion carried.

OAI Maintenance Agreement - Opportunity Advancement Innovation Agreement is an agreement to maintain the Rain Gardens. It is zero \$ cost to the City. It was discussed & voted on in Municipal Services then sent to Judiciary.. OAI provides services to lower income areas who do not necessarily have the resources and to help distressed areas. It is to weed & maintain 2 large gardens on Irving & 119th and one on 121st & Longwood.

- Before making the motion to accept, Alderman Hill asked when Mark Miller meets with OAI to point out that the soil needs to be evenly balanced out so there is no more run-off on constituent's property after watering and rain, 2nd by Cantelo-Zylman, Voice Vote, all in favor, motion carried.

Adjournment -. At 7:32 p.m. a motion was made by Alderman Cantelo-Zylman, 2nd by Alderman Hill, voice vote, all in favor, motion carried to adjourn.
