September 10th, 2015

Called to order at 6:06 p.m.

Public Works

Superintendent Poesterl reported to the committee the following

- 92.38 Tons of hot patch asphalt used
- 8 yards of concrete poured/sidewalk and curb repairs
- 19 Street Lights repaired/maintained
- 21 Com Ed repair requests submitted
- 15 Dead/Diseased Trees removed
- 47 Trees trimmed
- 80 dumpsters of Bulk Debris removed from the City, which adds up to roughly 1600 yards worth.
- JULIE REQUEST (Joint Utility Locating Information for Excavators) 187 locates and 10 were priority "0"

There was much discussion by the committee regarding the bulk waste pickup and how the city should handle this moving forward. It was decided to discuss further at detail at our next meeting.

Golf Course

Betty Harmeyer reported on the current activities at the golf course. She stated the weather has been cooperative and we have been doing really well with golf outings. There are already groups wanting to schedule outings for next year.

New Business

Under new business the committee heard a report from Jason Berry regarding the residential parking restrictions in town. He gave the committee a breakdown of existing regulations and explained the difference of "Resident Permit Parking" and "Permit Resident Parking."

The committee then discussed at detail the snow route and snow removal procedure, and after much discussion it was decided by the committee that staff should further investigate, research, and come up a plan of different priorities and this will be discussed further at our October meeting.

Lastly under new business the committee took up a proposal from a local restaurant in town Vinny's Place located at 13023 Western Ave. They are looking to get a couple 15 minute parking only signs along new street. There was a **Motion:** by Alderman Johanson and a **Second:** by Alderman Pittman to send this to judiciary to have an ordinance drafted. Voice vote was taken and **all were in favor.**
