WHEREAS, the City of Blue Island has the authority to contract and be contracted with pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/2-2-12;

WHEREAS, the City plans to enter into an agreement with PropertyRoom.com for the disposition of unclaimed or abandoned assets held by the Blue Island Police Department in the City of Blue Island

WHEREAS, the appropriate city officials have considered and reviewed the agreement attached as Exhibit A and find the same to be in the best interests of the City;

NOW AND THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: AGREEMENT FORM AND TERMS AUTHORIZED

The terms and conditions as shown in the Agreement attached as Exhibit A to this Resolution are hereby approved.

**SECTION 2: AUTHORIZATION OF AGENT TO EXECUTE AND ACT IN
ACCORDANCE WITH AGREEMENT**

The City Council further authorizes the Mayor or his designee to execute the attached Agreement with the Cook County Emergency Telephone System Board and any and all documentation that may be necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution. The officers, employees, and/or agents of the City shall take all action necessary or reasonably required by the City to carry out, give effect to, and consummate the intent of this Resolution.


SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE



Request for Board Action: Motion to enter into an agreement with PropertyRoom.com for property & evidence auction services.

Overview: The Department does not currently have a vendor to manage and conduct the auction of abandoned/unclaimed property held in the custody of the Blue Island Police Department. PropertyRoom.com arranges for surplus, abandoned and unclaimed property to be picked up from the Department, evaluated and auctioned online. The Department would receive a portion of the proceeds for sold items and the remaining items would be disposed of. Auctioning this property maintained at the Department would increase the amount of storage available in the evidence room and decrease the amount of time that staff is spending on auditing the items in custody.

Options and Recommendation: PropertyRoom.com works with over 3,000 departments nationwide to auction unclaimed, surplus property, including the Chicago Police Department. Utilizing PropertyRoom.com would lower the amount of hours spent by our staff cataloging and arranging auctions for surplus property.
