**ORDINANCE NUMBER 2021-053**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BLUE ISLAND, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AMENDING CHAPTER 50, "GARBAGE COLLECTION" OF THE CODE OF BLUE ISLAND, ILLINOIS**

---

**WHEREAS**, the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois (the "*City*") is a duly organized and existing City created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, with full powers to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions for the benefits of the residents of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Aldermen may from time to time amend the text of the City Code of Blue Island (the "*Code*") when it is determined to be in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the City and its residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the City currently regulates garbage collection throughout the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Aldermen desire to modify the Code and create efficient and effective systems for the regulation and enforcement of garbage collection within the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Aldermen find that the following amendments to the Code of Blue Island, Illinois, as set forth herein, are in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the City and its residents.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and City Aldermen of the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

**Section 1.** That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

**Section 2.** That the Mayor and City Aldermen find and determine that the adoption of this Ordinance is in the best interests of the City as well as in the best interests of the public.

**Section 3.** That Chapter 50 (“*Garbage Collection*”) of Title V (“*Public Works*”) of the Code of Blue Island, Illinois is hereby amended by deleting the stricken language and adding the underlined language as follows:

**§ 50.01 DEFINITIONS**

For the purposes of this subchapter, the following definitions shall apply unless the context clearly indicates or requires a different meaning.

***ASHES.*** All solid residue resulting from the combustion of coal, coke, wood, or other substances, including soot, cinders, slag, and charcoal.

***BULK WASTE.*** Household items that are too large to reasonably fit in the resident’s City garbage receptacle and are equal to or less than two (2) cubic yards in total size. Bulk Waste does not include garbage or waste as defined in this Section, hazardous substances, tires, construction/demolition debris, automotive repairs, and other ineligible materials.

**§ 50.04 SPECIAL SERVICE.**

No garbage, ashes or waste shall be allowed to accumulate on any property or premises within the city other than in the receptacles described in Section 50.02, for a period longer than the time between calls by the city at the property or premises for the purpose of collecting the same. If bulk waste is placed at the curb for removal, the waste is of such character or quantity that the regular collectors making the regular trips do not collect it, then the occupant of such premises shall make a request for the special bulk waste pick-up service to the Department of Public Works no later than one week 24 hours after the accumulation thereof and placement on the curb. service, the Superintendent of Streets shall make a reasonable charge for the Any garbage, waste, or bulk waste measuring more than two (2) cubic yards must be removed by the occupant of the premises immediately; but in no case may any garbage, waste, or bulk garbage greater than two (2) cubic yards remain on a City curb for more than twenty-four (24) hours. If a resident violates this section of the municipal code, the resident will be subject to a municipal code citation; and upon a finding of liability, fined pursuant to Chapter 39 of the City Code. Ashes shall not be collected by the city from June 1 through September 30 each year, except on special request; in such case a reasonable charge shall be made for the service.

**Section 4.** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.


**Section 5.** All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 6.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.






