**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BLUE ISLAND, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS
RESTRICTING A PORTION OF A CERTAIN STREET FOR HANDICAPPED PARKING
ONLY AT OR NEAR 12810 GREENWOOD AVENUE WITHIN THE CITY OF BLUE
ISLAND, COUNTY OF COOK AND STATE OF ILLINOIS AND PROVIDING
PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF**

WHEREAS, the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois (the “*City*”) is a duly organized and existing city created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and is now operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, with full powers to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions for the benefits of the residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, it is the public policy of the State of Illinois, as enunciated in the State Constitution, that handicapped persons are entitled to enjoy the fruits of a full and meaningful life; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Blue Island hereby declare that it is the public policy of the city to encourage and assist handicapped persons to participate fully in the social and economic life of our community; and

WHEREAS, a resident has submitted an application to the City for a temporary handicap parking sign at the 12810 Greenwood Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Section 72.14 of the Blue Island Municipal Code sets forth the regulations for handicapped parking within the City; and

WHEREAS, the requirements of Section 72.14(B) are hereby waived to the fullest extent allowed by law; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Blue Island (the “*City Council*,” or the “*Corporate Authorities*”) find that the approval of the temporary handicap parking sign at 12810 Greenwood Avenue is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the City and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Corporate Authorities of the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. That the Corporate Authorities find and determine that the adoption of this Ordinance is in the best interests of the City as well as in the public interest.

Section 3. That as prescribed by Section 72.14 of the Blue Island Municipal Code this portion of the street within the City of Blue Island, as hereinafter designated, is hereby restricted for handicapped parking only:

- a) On the west side of Greenwood Avenue in front of the residence whose common address is 12810 Greenwood Avenue (one space consisting of a total of twenty (20') feet)

Section 4. Appropriate signs shall be erected by the Superintendent of Public Works at the property designated above informing the public that parking thereon is restricted or permitted as hereinabove provided for.

Section 5. The operator of any vehicle violating or failing to comply with the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction be fined not less than Three Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$350.00) for each offense.

Section 6. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held

invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 7. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 8. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, approval to ensure the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City.


