ORDINANCE NUMBER 2021-23

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BLUE ISLAND, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS,
AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 2021-001 THAT CREATED TRAFFIC
REGULATIONS AT THE INTERSECTION OF MAPLE AVENUE AND 122ND PLACE**

WHEREAS, the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois (the “City”) is a duly organized and existing city created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and is now operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, with full powers to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions for the benefits of the residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, on January 26, 2021 the Mayor and Aldermen passed Ordinance Number 2021-001 that created traffic regulations at the intersection of Maple Avenue and 122nd Place. Ordinance Number 2021-001 is attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, a scrivener’s error exists in Ordinance Number 2021-001 that erroneously states the location of the necessary traffic regulations to be placed at the intersection of 122nd Place and Maple Avenue instead of the correct intersection of 122nd Street and Maple Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Blue Island deem it necessary to amend Ordinance Number 2021-001 in order to remove the scrivener’s error so that the correct streets have stop signs as intended by Ordinance Number 2021-001.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. That the Mayor Aldermen find and determine that the adoption of this

Ordinance is in the best interests of the City as well as in the public interest.

Section 3. The Mayor and Aldermen find that Ordinance 2021-001 is hereby amended by deleting the following stricken language and adding the underlined language:

(a) Title: An Ordinance Requiring Vehicular Traffic to Top at a Certain Location within the City of Blue Island, Cook County, State of Illinois, and Providing Penalties for Violation Thereof (Maple Ave and 122nd ~~Place~~ Street);

(b) Section 2: (a) Northbound on Maple Avenue at the intersection with 122nd ~~Place~~ Street.

(b) Southbound on Maple Avenue at the intersection with 122nd ~~Place~~ Street.

(c) Eastbound on Maple Avenue at the intersection with 122nd ~~Place~~ Street.

(c) Section 3: Appropriate traffic signs shall be erected by the Superintendent of Public Works on each corner at or near the intersection of Maple Avenue and 122nd ~~Place~~ Street, informing the public that vehicular traffic traveling in every direction must stop before said intersection.

Section 4. The amendments set forth in Section 3 of this Ordinance, amending the scrivener's error in Ordinance Number 2021-001, shall be in full force and effect retroactive to the effective date of Ordinance Number 2021-001.

Section 5. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 6. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval to ensure the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City.


