**ORDINANCE NUMBER 2021-33**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BLUE ISLAND, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS,  
REQUIRING ONE-WAY VEHICULAR TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CITY AND  
PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF  
(Eisenhower High School Traffic Regulation)**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois (the “*City*”) is a duly organized and existing City created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, with full powers to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions for the benefits of the residents of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, Title VII, Chapter 71 of the Blue Island, Illinois Code of Ordinances (“City Code”) allows for one-way streets within the city;

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Aldermen desire to create traffic patterns to address the safety hazards and concerns surrounding Eisenhower High School; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Aldermen find that the following vehicular traffic requirements are in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the City and its residents.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and City Aldermen of the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

**Section 1.** That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

**Section 2.** That the Mayor and City Aldermen find and determine that the adoption of this Ordinance is in the best interests of the City as well as in the best interests of the public.

**Section 3.** That any vehicle proceeding on the following streets on school days between the hours of 7:45 am and 9:45 am and between the hours of 2:45 pm and 3:45 pm shall abide by the one-way traffic signs to be erected in the following areas:

- (a) Sacramento Avenue between Walnut Street and 127<sup>th</sup> Street, One-Way Northbound Traffic Only;
- (b) Edison Avenue between Wahl Street and Sacramento Avenue, One-Way Westbound Traffic Only;
- (c) Walnut Street between Wahl Street and Sacramento Avenue, One-Way Westbound Traffic Only; and
- (d) Burr Oak Avenue South Alley, One-Way Eastbound Traffic Only.

**Section 4.** No vehicle may park on the east side of Sacramento Avenue between Edison Avenue and 127<sup>th</sup> Street on school days between the hours of 7:45 am and 9:45 am and between the hours of 2:45 pm and 3:45 pm.

**Section 5.** The operator of any vehicle violating or failing to comply with any provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) nor more than Seven Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$750.00) for each offense.

**Section 6.** Appropriate signs shall be erected by Public Works Department on the streets designated above informing the public regarding the One-Way Traffic Requirements.

**Section 7.** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

**Section 8.** All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 9.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
