ORDINANCE NUMBER 2021-036

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BLUE ISLAND, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AMENDING TITLE IX, CHAPTER 90 "ANIMALS" OF THE CODE OF BLUE ISLAND, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois (the "*City*") is a duly organized and existing City created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, with full powers to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions for the benefits of the residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Aldermen may from time to time amend the text of the City Code of Blue Island (the "*Code*") when it is determined to be in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the City and its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Aldermen desire to modify the Code and create efficient and effective systems for the regulation and enforcement of animal registration and responsibility within the City; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Aldermen find that the following amendments to the Code of Blue Island, Illinois, as set forth herein, are in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the City and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Aldermen of the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. That the Mayor and City Aldermen find and determine that the adoption of this Ordinance is in the best interests of the City as well as in the best interests of the public.

Section 3. That Chapter 90 (“*Animals*”) of Title IX (“*General Regulations*”) of the Code of Blue Island, Illinois is hereby amended by deleting the stricken language and adding the underlined language as follows:

§ 90.062 REDEMPTION OF UNLICENSED ANIMALS.

(A) For every animal taken up and impounded, as provided in this subchapter, for which no license fee has been paid to the City, there shall be paid to the Animal Control and Welfare Officer, for the use of the city, by any ~~person-resident~~ desiring to redeem such animal, the total of the following fees:

- (1) A ~~\$10~~ \$25 redemption fee for male and spayed female animals;
- (2) A ~~\$20~~ \$50 redemption fee for un-spayed female animals; and
- (3) A ~~\$5~~ \$20 redemption fee for each day of impoundment or fraction thereof.

(B) ~~If such amounts be paid by any person desiring to redeem such an animal within five days after the impounding thereof, such person shall be entitled to redeem such animal provided, however, that No animal can be redeemed by a resident if the animal does not have a unless the current City license certificate tag. If the animal does not have a current City license, the resident must pay \$50, in addition to the fees listed above, to the Animal Control and Welfare Officer, who will register the animal with the City and provide the appropriate license tag. to and tag for said animal be first procured and shown.~~

§ 90.066 IMPOUNDING FEES.

The fees to be charged by the Animal Control and Welfare Officer for impoundment ~~shall be \$10, plus \$5 per day for each day subsequent to the day of impoundment where redemption is made by the owner~~ are as described in Section 90.062 above.

Section 4. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 5. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


Section 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.






