**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BLUE ISLAND, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS,
AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING FUNDING FOR RETENTION OF
PUBLIC WORKS EMPLOYEES**

WHEREAS, the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois (the “City”) is a duly organized and existing City created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, with full powers to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions for the benefits of the residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, there is an existing emergent shortage of public works employees in the Blue Island Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Aldermen desire to approve funding for the retention of fur (4) additional full-time and four (4) additional part-time public works employees at the rate of pay agreed to in the collective bargaining agreement in order to improve the efficiency of the Public Works Department; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Aldermen of the City of Blue Island deem it advisable and in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City to authorize funding for the retention of additional public works employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Aldermen of the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. That the Mayor and City Aldermen find and determine that the adoption of

this Resolution is in the best interests of the City as well as in the best interests of the public.

Section 3. The Mayor and City Aldermen approve funding for the retention of four (4) full-time and four (4) part-time public works employees at the rate of pay agreed to in the collective bargaining agreement.

Section 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to implement the funding of these positions as described herein.

Section 4. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Resolution shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Resolution.

Section 5. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


Section 8. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


