A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BLUE ISLAND, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS,  
AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING A BLOCK PARTY ON MARKET STREET  
ON JUNE 26, 2021

**WHEREAS**, the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois (the “City”) is a duly organized and existing City created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, with full powers to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions for the benefits of the residents of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City wants to promote and facilitate the gathering of neighbors in a safe environment;

**WHEREAS**, Miguel Saucedo, a Blue Island resident, has requested permission from the City to have a block party on Market Street between Hoyne and Division Streets, on June 26, 2021 from 4:00 pm – 10:00 pm;

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Aldermen of the City of Blue Island deem it advisable and in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City to approve the application for this block party, as long as the procedures and regulations are followed and all required forms are completed with accurate information and are signed by the appropriate block party representatives.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Aldermen of the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

**Section 1.** That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

**Section 2.** That the Mayor and City Aldermen find and determine that the adoption of this Resolution is in the best interests of the City as well as in the best interests of the public as long as Blue Island City Code is followed.

**Section 3.** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Resolution shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Resolution.

**Section 4.** All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 5.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
