**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BLUE ISLAND, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS,
APPOINTING DEPUTY CITY ADMINISTRATOR, MARK PATOSKA, AS LOCAL
GOVERNMENT DIRECTOR OF THE SOUTH SUBURBAN LAND
BANK AND DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY**

WHEREAS, the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois (the “*City*”) is a duly organized and existing city created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and is now operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, with full powers to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions for the benefits of the residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, the South Suburban Land Bank and Development Authority (“SSLBDA”) has requested that each Member appoint a local representative to serve as a Local Government Director of the Land Bank; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Aldermen of the City find that the appointment of Deputy City Administrator, Mark Patoska, as the City’s Local Government Director to the SSLBDA is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the City and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Corporate Authorities of the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. That the Mayor and City Aldermen find and determine that the adoption of this Resolution is in the best interests of the City as well as in the public interest.

Section 3. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Resolution shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Resolution.

Section 4. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, approval to ensure the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City


