**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BLUE ISLAND, COOK
COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AMENDING TITLE IX,
CHAPTER 90 “ANIMALS” OF THE
CODE OF BLUE ISLAND, ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois (the “*City*”) is a duly organized and existing City created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, with full powers to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions for the benefits of the residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Blue Island may from time to time amend the text of the City Code of Blue Island (the “*Code*”) when it is determined to be in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the City and its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Animal Control Act, 510 ILCS 5/1 *et seq.* authorizes municipalities to regulate dogs and other animals; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Alderman of the City desire to modify the Code to regulate sanitation as it relates to owners of animals within the City;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Alderman of the City find that the following amendments to the Code of Blue Island, Illinois, as set forth herein, are in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the City and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Alderman of the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. That the Mayor and City Aldermen find and determine that the adoption of this Ordinance is in the best interests of the City as well as in the best interests of the public.

Section 3. That Section 90.100 (“*Collection and Disposal of Refuse*”) of Chapter 90 (“*Animals*”) of Title IX (“*General Regulations*”) of the Code of Blue Island, Illinois is hereby amended by deleting the stricken language and adding the underlined language to read, as follows:

§ 90.100 COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF REFUSE

- (A)** The owner or custodian of any animal shall collect, or cause to be collected, immediately all filth, offal, soil or defecation on any public property or upon any street, sidewalk, public way, play area, or common grounds owned jointly by members of a homeowner’s association, or upon private property other than that of the owner. ~~or other~~ The refuse and shall keep the same be collected immediately in air-tight containers or plastic bag and disposed of ~~for disposal in a manner as otherwise may be permitted by law.~~ accordance with this code of ordinances concerning health and sanitation or, in the absence of applicable provisions, in accordance with the direction of the Health Officer.
- (B)** No person owning, harboring or keeping an animal within the City shall permit any waste matter from the animal to collect and remain on the property of the owner or custodian so as to cause or create an unhealthy, unsanitary, dangerous or offensive living condition on the owner's or custodian's property, or to abutting property of others, as determined by the City’s Building Department.
- (C)** No person owning, harboring, keeping or in charge of any animal shall cause unsanitary dangerous or offensive conditions by virtue of the size or number of animals maintained at a single location or due to the inadequacy of the facilities, as determined by the City’s Building Department.

Section 4. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 5. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


