**ORDINANCE NUMBER 2022- 014**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BLUE ISLAND, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, REQUIRING ONE-WAY VEHICULAR TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CITY AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THE SAME (VETERANS MEMORIAL MIDDLE SCHOOL)**

---

**WHEREAS**, the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois (the “*City*”) is a duly organized and existing City created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, with full powers to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions for the benefits of the residents of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Aldermen may from time to time amend the text of the City Code of Blue Island (the “*Code*”) when it is determined to be in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the City and its residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the City currently regulates traffic throughout the City; and

**WHEREAS**, Title VII, Chapter 71 of the Code allows for one-way streets within the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Aldermen desire to create traffic patterns to address safety hazards and concerns surrounding Veterans Memorial Middle School; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Aldermen find that the following amendments to the Code of Blue Island, Illinois, as set forth herein, are in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the City and its residents.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and City Aldermen of the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

**Section 1.** That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

**Section 2.** That the Mayor and City Aldermen find and determine that the adoption of this Ordinance is in the best interests of the City as well as in the best interests of the public.

**Section 3.** That any vehicle proceeding on the following streets on school days between the hours of 7:30 am and 8:30 am and between the hours of 2:00 pm to 3:00 pm shall abide by the one way traffic signs to be erected in the following areas:

- (a) Greenwood Avenue between 123<sup>rd</sup> Street and Grunewald Avenue: One-Way Southbound Traffic Only.

**Section 4.** The operator of any vehicle violating or failing to comply with any provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) and not more than Seven Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$750.00) for each offense.

**Section 5.** Appropriate signs shall be erected by Public Works Department on the street designated above informing the public regarding the One-Way Traffic Requirements.

**Section 6.** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

**Section 7.** All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 8.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


