**ORDINANCE NUMBER 2022- 026**

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**WHEREAS**, the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois (the “City”) is a duly organized and existing City created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, with full powers to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions for the benefits of the residents of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, Title VII, Chapter 72, Section 72.09 of the Blue Island, Illinois Code of Ordinances (“City Code”) allows the City to create restricted parking areas from time to time;

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Aldermen of the City desire to create a residential only parking restriction on the north and south side of the 2900 Block of Everett Street; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Aldermen of the City find that the following residential parking restriction is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the City and its residents.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

**Section 1.** That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

**Section 2.** That the Mayor and City Aldermen find and determine that the adoption of this Ordinance is in the best interests of the City as well as in the best interests of the public.

**Section 3.** No nonresidential persons shall stop, stand, or park on the northside or southside of the street of the 2900 block of Everett Street in Blue Island, Illinois.

**Section 4.** The operator of any vehicle violating or failing to comply with any provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) nor more than Seven Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$750.00) for each offense.

**Section 5.** Appropriate signs shall be erected by the Public Works Department on the street designated above informing the public regarding the Residential Only Parking Requirement.

**Section 6.** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

**Section 7.** All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 8.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.



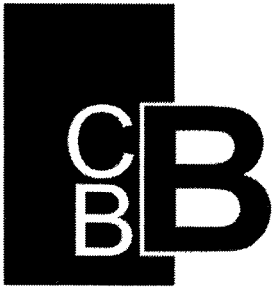

Two bids for the subject project were received and opened on April 6, 2023, shortly after 10:00 a.m. The bids are summarized below and tabulated in detail on the attached spreadsheet.

Our review comments are as follows:

1. All bidders submitted the required 10% Bid Bond.
2. There were no Addendums to acknowledged receipt of.
3. There were no Exceptions and Deviations from any of the bidders.
4. CBBEL recommends that the City award a contract in the amount of \$241,830.00 to Utility Dynamics Corporation of Oswego, Illinois for the Roadway LED Conversion Project. Utility Dynamics Corporation has provided the lowest responsive bid and is considered qualified to perform the work. CBBEL has worked on numerous projects with Utility Dynamics Corporation that were completed successfully.
