ORDINANCE NUMBER

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WHEREAS, the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois (the “City”) is a duly organized and existing City created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, with full powers to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions for the benefits of the residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Aldermen may from time to time approve ordinances of the City relating to vehicular traffic regulation when it is determined to be in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the City and its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Aldermen find that adding a stop signs at the north, south, and west sides of the intersection of 122nd Street and Irving Avenue is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the City and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Aldermen of the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. That the Mayor and City Aldermen find and determine that the adoption of this Ordinance is in the best interests of the City as well as in the best interests of the public.

Section 3. The operator of any vehicle proceeding through the intersection of 122nd Street and Irving Avenue within the City of Blue Island, shall stop such vehicle at the stop signs located in

this intersection, except when directed to proceed by a police officer or as otherwise provided by law.

Section 4. Appropriate traffic signs shall be erected by the Superintendent of Public Works at this intersection, informing the public that vehicular traffic must stop before entering the intersection.

Section 5. The operator of any vehicle violating or failing to comply with any provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not less than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00) for each offense, and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

Section 6. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 7. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 8. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.




