AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BLUE ISLAND, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AMENDING TITLE III (“ADMINISTRATION”), CHAPTER 32 (“CITY ORGANIZATIONS”) OF THE CODE OF BLUE ISLAND, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois (the “*City*”) is a duly organized and existing City created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, with full powers to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions for the benefits of the residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Blue Island may from time to time amend the text of the City Code of Blue Island (the “*Code*”) when it is determined to be in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the City and its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Blue Island determined that it is necessary to create a Special Events Committee to recommend and plan City sponsored events, including but not limited to the Christmas Light Parade and the 4th of July Parade; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Aldermen of the City find that the following amendments to the Code of Blue Island, Illinois, as set forth herein, are in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the City and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Aldermen of the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Aldermen of the City find and determine that the adoption of this Ordinance is in the best interests of the City as well as in the best interests of

the public.

Section 3. That Chapter 32 (“*City Organizations*”) of Title III (“*Administration*”) of the Code of Blue Island, Illinois is hereby amended by adding the underlined language to read, as follows:

§32.06 Special Events Committee

(A) Short title. This section shall be known and may be cited as “The Blue Island Special Events Committee Ordinance”.

(B) Creation. A Special Events Committee is hereby created for the city.

(C) Membership, appointment, tenure and compensation.

(1) The Committee shall consist of five members to be appointed by the Mayor subject to the confirmation of the City Council.

(2) The members of the Committee shall be appointed for three-year terms.

(3) Appointments to fill a vacancy shall be for the remainder of the unexpired terms only.

(4) All members of the Committee shall serve without compensation for their services as members of the Committee.

(5) The Secretary of the Committee may be a non-member thereof and if so, shall have no vote.

(D) Organization, bylaws and meetings.

(1) The Committee shall organize the election of a Chairperson and such other officers as it deems necessary. Such officers shall hold office for a term of three years and may succeed themselves.

(2) The Committee shall adopt such bylaws governing its procedures and

regulating its business as it, from time to time, deems proper and necessary, consistent with city ordinances or state laws heretofore or hereafter in force and effect. The adoption and amendment of the bylaws shall be by a majority vote of the members of the Committee. The Committee shall keep written records of its proceedings which shall be open to public inspection.

(E) Powers and duties. The Committee shall work in coordination with the city administration to plan and prepare for City sponsored special events within the City. The Committee will formulate and carry out specific strategies to achieve this objective.

(F) Annual report. The Committee shall submit an annual written report to the City Council not later than June 1 of each year.

Section 4. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 5. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.




