

# NOTICE OF PROMOTIONAL EXAMINATION FOR FIRE LIEUTENANT FOR THE CITY OF BLUE ISLAND


The Civil Service Commission of the City of Blue Island will conduct a Promotional Examination for Fire Lieutenant on July 16, 2018 and July 23, 2018. The Subjective Evaluation Component of the examination will be conducted on July 16, 2018 beginning at 9:00 a.m. The Written Examination Component will be conducted July 23, 2018 beginning at 9:00 a.m. Both exams will be held in the Civil Service Commission room located in the East Annex located at 2434 Vermont Street, Blue Island, Illinois.

Participation in the examination is limited to all non – probationary full – time members of the City of Blue Island Fire Department who have been employed for at least three consecutive years on the Blue Island Fire Department as of the date that the notice of the test is posted by the City. Persons interested in participating in the examination must notify the Fire Chief in writing on or before June 15, 2018. Anyone that provides notification after this date and time will not be allowed to participate in the examination.

The Civil Service Commission requires a minimum passing score of 70 on the examination for Fire Lieutenant in order for a candidate to be placed on the promotional register of persons eligible for promotion to the position of Fire Lieutenant. The score will be an aggregate of the Seniority, Merit, Subjective and Written Components of the testing process.

If applicable with respect to this examination, applicants requesting merit points must do so in writing at the time when they notify the Fire Chief of their participation in the test. Written proof of the required certification(s) to qualify for merit points must be provided by the applicant to the Fire Chief at the time of notification to participate in the examination.
