A RESOLUTION HONORING COLUMBUS “CHRIS” DISABATO

WHEREAS, certain individuals unselfishly volunteer and continuously provide acts of public service for the benefit of others; and

WHEREAS, these individuals deserve recognition and thanks because they volunteer and perform these countless acts of community service selflessly; and

WHEREAS, during his life Columbus “Chris” Disabato was one of these kind, generous and dedicated persons who regularly volunteered his time and expertise to help make Blue Island the great community it is today; and

WHEREAS, Chris was also a wonderful husband and father, marrying his childhood sweetheart, Sylvia Rubino, in 1945, and who together raised their two children, Christine and Alan; and

WHEREAS, Chris during his life served the City of Blue Island in many positions over a period of more than forty (40) years as Mayor, Alderman, City Treasurer, member of the Civil Service Commission, Treasurer of the Blue Island Historical Society and as a Director of Main Street Blue Island; and

WHEREAS, Chris also bravely served his country during World War II as a member of the United States Infantry, proudly attaining the rank of Sergeant and being honorably discharged; and

WHEREAS, Chris was also a faithful member of St. Donatus Church, as well as an active supporter of Blue Cap School, the Lions Club and the Knights of Columbus; and

WHEREAS, throughout his entire life Chris generously dedicated his time and quietly did all of these wonderful things for others without any thought of recognition for himself; and

WHEREAS, Chris's lifetime of good works, public service, community involvement and love for his wife, children, and the residents of the City of Blue Island is deserving of special recognition and remembrance by all of the citizens of Blue Island he helped and assisted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Blue Island, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Members of the City Council wish to memorialize Columbus "Chris" Disabato's acts of kindness, generosity and community service during his life and remember him for all of the goodwill he bestowed upon the residents of Blue Island.
